VALOR – The new Erasmus+ dissemination platform

The Erasmus+ programme has now been running for $1\frac{1}{2}$ years, which is why we would like to take this opportunity to take a look at one of the tools that is included in the new programme for the dissemination of projects and their outcomes: the Erasmus+ dissemination platform VALOR. The platform includes details of all projects that received funding from the European Commission via the Erasmus+ programme in the areas of Education, Training, Youth and Sport, together with their outcomes. What is more, it also contains all of the projects accessible in ADAM and EST.

By using VALOR, Project Leaders are able to publish the current status of their projects and make their projects and the outcomes of those projects accessible to a wider audience. The Erasmus+dissemination was conceived as a showcase for good practices and as a repository for all projects and products created under the Erasmus+ programme. It highlights success stories and projects that aim to develop good practices, enabling all interested parties to retrieve and make use of the information generated by the projects. The platform is intended to serve as a source of inspiration and to develop into a Community of Practice with regard to projects.

Since the start of July, all of the projects funded during 2014 and 2015 can be accessed via the platform. The platform provides detailed information regarding the projects, including a project description and information about the project coordinator(s) and project partners. Once the project is complete, the products themselves will also be available.

Thematic Monitoring in the field of EQF / NQF



Under the Lifelong Learning Programme numerous projects on learning outcomes and in the field of European/National Qualifications Frameworks (EQF / NQF) have been successfully developed and implemented.

These projects have not only fostered the exchange of experiences, but have also developed new products, methods as well as curricula. For some, the preparation and description of qualifications was the project goal. For others, the key project objective focused on the learning outcome oriented description of trainings enabling a future assignment to the corresponding qualifications framework.

Since 2012 we, the NKS Coordination Point for the NQF Austria, have highlighted these projects in ADAM, the project and product portal for Leonardo da Vinci, to make their results and outcomes more easily accessible.

Now we would like to go one step forward and start a thematic monitoring activity, aiming at identifying successful projects in the field of EQF/NQF, collecting their project results and analysing these to derive conclusions and recommendations both for the participating international partners, promoters, educational institutions and relevant stakeholders but also for the actual implementation of the qualifications frameworks.

Certi.MenTu - Certification for **Mentors and Tutors**



Every month a project which has been particularly well presented in ADAM is selected as Project of the Month. July's Project of the Month is "Certi.MenTu", a transfer innovation project coordinated in Austria.

Certi.MenTu is a project that seeks to address the issue of certification for mentors and tutors.

Mentors are individuals employed within a company, who help an individual learner to develop his/her abilities and knowledge and to identify connections. Tutors are teachers or trainers, who normally do not come from within the sector concerned, but who assist individuals or small groups of people undertaking workplace-based learning.

Certi.MenTu is intended to promote the sharing of experiences between employers and institutions providing vocational training and continuina education, in order to create a more in-depth understanding of the needs of learners in the workplace.
