

# Budget for an internship in Malta

# Prices cover the period 1/1/2008 - 31/12/2008

### Accommodation

We suggest double or triple rooms in shared apartment or student's residence for stays of more than 3 weeks. For shorter stays we recommend a hotel.

The students will share the bathroom/ kitchen and living area. Linen is provided but the food, toiletries and detergents are to be supplied by the students. The price includes the cost of insurance of the residence, electricity and water.

Period – 1/1/2008-31/5/2008 and 1/10/2008-31/12/2008

Euros 12.00 per day

Period - 1/06/2008-30/09/2008

Euros 19.00 per day

Students are to book accommodation through Future Focus in the school's own student residences or in properties under contract with the school. We guarantee that accommodation is licenced according to the Malta Tourism Authority rules for such properties.

We will choose the property according to its vicinity to the work place. In doing so we try to ensure that the student takes only one bus to work or classes. Although this cannot be guaranteed we try our best to ensure that time spend on public transport is kept to a minimum.

We offer also choices of 3/4/5 star hotels for the teachers/ co-ordinators and private students who prefer this option. Please see our brochure for full details.

# Tutoring and administration

The fee charged for tutoring and administration is Euro 173 per student. In cases where the student opts to follow a course of English with Future Focus the fee for tutoring is reduced to Euro 120. This fee covers the cost of monitoring the student, coaching on a one-to-one basis, handling of contract documentation and so on. Future Focus will also help to provide a doctor if the student falls sick during the internship however it is important that the student has his/ her own health/ medical insurance before coming to Malta.

#### English language or other courses

Students fluent in English who would prefer to follow a course in some other subject such as marketing, advertising, public relations and so on are requested to visit the website for details of all the subjects available; <u>www.futurefocus.com.mt</u> The price for such course is obtained from Future Focus because it will depend on the number of hours needed by the student.

# Local transport/ transport to and from the airport

See the brochure on Local transport. All students will be met upon arrival at the airport. Euros 46 is charged for the pick up to and from the airport however if a individual student (not a group) is coming to Malta and staying in our student residence, the pick up is usually provided for free.

### **Cultural programme**

This is optional. The excursions to the Maltese highlights are organised on Saturday. The fee is Euro 25 per excursion. It includes the transport and guide but does not include any meals. Our excursion programme includes visits to Mdina – the old capital city, a day trip to the island of Gozo; Valletta and the three cities and a visit to the 5000 year old temples. These excursions should not be missed!

### Pocket money

Future Focus does not get involved in subsistence although it might do so upon specific request from the school or university. Euros 10 per day should be enough to cover the cost of food and other living expenses.g6bu
