

SUMMER POLISH LANGUAGE COURSE FOR FOREIGNERS INTENDING TO STUDY AT THE STATE HIGHER VOCATIONAL SCHOOL IN NYSA

The course along with the examination entitles ONLY to study at the State Higher Vocational School in Nysa.

Description of the course:

- Duration – 3 weeks (03.09. – 21.09.2007),
- It includes A0 – A2 levels (learning from fundamentals) according to the Common European Framework (CEF),
- It includes 76 hours of linguistic classes and 14 hours of additional classes dealing with various aspects of Polish culture and realities,
- Curriculum of the course includes two sightseeing tours (within the framework of learning culture and realities). During the first one students will be familiarized with culture, architecture and nature of Nysa region,
- Price list:
 - ✓ The course and examination fee – **460 PLN (~ 125 Euro)**
 - ✓ Only examination fee, without participation in the course – **230 PLN (~60 Euro)**
 - ✓ Accommodation and board are NOT included in the price! Reduced charge for accommodation in students' dormitory for course participants – **270 PLN (~75 Euro)**,
 - ✓ Students must pay Health insurance themselves in the National Health Fund or in one of the insurance company. Health insurance is about **40 PLN (~10 Euro)**

Description of abilities acquired after completion of the course:

A person who completes the course is able to:

1. Recognise, read and understand:

- phrases and the highest frequency vocabulary related to areas of most immediate personal relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local area, employment, signs, doctors' tips)
- specific, predictable information in simple everyday material such as simple messages and announcements, advertisements, prospectuses, menus and timetables and short simple personal letters, short press notes, media information (e. g. at the train station, at the airport, in the travel agency),
- lyrics of simply songs and short stories with uncomplicated plot,
- assignment and problems in handbooks and during school classes.

2. Can:

- communicate and interact in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar topics and activities
- lead a simple conversation on general subjects and handle very short social exchanges,
- communicate in the majority of everyday situations (e. g. in shop, at school, in means of communications/transport, in insurance agency),
- acquire and pass an important information during direct and phone conversation,
- express feelings (e. g. happiness, astonishment, dissatisfaction),
- react properly in everyday communicative situations,
- tell about various events and comment them,
- express own feelings and discuss on uncomplicated subjects,
- tell about read book or watched movie,
- tell about an event, anecdote, joke in a simple way,
- formulate statements concerning plans for future and dreams as well as statements concerning events from the past,
- fill in a simple form (e. g. personal data, to write a cheque etc.).
